- Updates on Search for new Dean of Academic Affairs
 - Memo will be delivered to Peter on Friday

 - There have been questions from folks as to why all of the candidates are white men
 - Variety of factors impacted the pool of candidates including: people choosing not to share demographic information in the application, people dropping out of the process etc...

 - Questions as to whether this will disconnect them from the rest of the department of APO
 - Candidate were required to write a DEI statement
 - The survey sent to everyone asking for feedback did not ask how they viewed the DEI statements
 - General sentiment that the survey didn't totally reflect the key attributes from the application
