Guest Dan Lowenstein, Middle School Outreach Program: Told us about the original WHSG Program (PI Ann McNichol) to do outreach to New Heights Charter School of Brockton, Keith Middle School of New Bedford, and Cyrus Peirce school on Nantucket (pending). Strongest tie is to Keith Middle School. Mission is to add to the teacher's curriculum and a whole grade section, not just one-off scientist classroom visits.
