- Divestment Discussion
  - Originally sparked by the open letter on Gaza/Israel conflict. Divestment from weapons and past discussions on fossil fuel divestment
  - Step 1 is determining what is WHOIs portfolio? What do we invest in?
  - Types of divestment:
    - Institutional
      - Personal: we can provide guidelines on how someone can do that individually
        - Perhaps this is a good place for the committee to start
  - How is our portfolio managed? How is the board involved? Let's ask Kathryn for a presentation on this
  - Might we be able to make a softer demand asking if divestment might be carried out over 7 years or something like that.
  - We can serve as a resource for folks who are thinking at divesting at an individual level
  - Empower (company that manages our investments) does offer 1 on 1s
    - Could we reach out to Empower to get resources on this?
    - ELISE: look into this for next time
    - There is a 1-866-467-7756 number that we can call at any time
  - What about a CommuniTea on divestment?
    - And/or collaborate with People Ops
  - BEN/JULIE: invite Kathryn in the fall to come present to us on this subject
